Last term the class with the best overall attendance were Year 1. Well done ! Our family support worker Hayley has been with year 1 today showing them how to make ice cream and sampling the results.

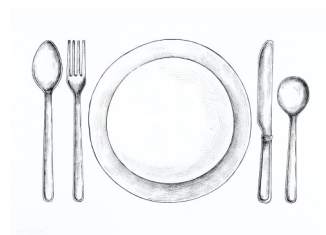


School Menu

Covid 19

If your child is displaying any covid 19 symptoms such as a high temperature, new and continuous cough and loss or change to sense of smell or taste please keep them at home and request a covid test by ringing 119. This is a PCR test.

In addition to this, you can now request your own supplies of lateral flow tests (LFT) for regular testing of your household even if you do not have symptoms. You should test your household regularly as about 1 in 3 people with covid-19 do not have symptoms but can still infect others.

Getting tested regularly is the only way to know if you have the virus.
