School Meal Price Increase

We have been notified by Lancashire County Council that from September there will be an increase in the daily price of a school meal from £2.30 to £2.35.

If your child is currently in Year 2 and you have not registered for free school meals, please be advised that universal free school meals comes to an end as your child enters KS2. If you haven't registered for free school meals, the cost of a meal per day will be £2.35 and you will need to ensure you have registered on Parentpay to make payment.
