Autumn 1: Learning in ...



<u>English</u>

We will be basing all our English work on the novel 'There's a boy in the girls' bathroom by Louis Sachar. We shall be writing play scripts, diaries and letters. We will also be learning about ways to create complex sentences and use a range of punctuation in our independent writing.

History and Geography

Our history topic is all about the civilisation of ancient Greece. We will be looking at ancient Greek artefacts and finding out about how the ancient Greeks have affected our world today. We will find out about how ancient Greece was ruled and about a day in the life of a soldier.
