# **English**

The first unit we will look at is based on a short film called 'The Piano.' From this we will be writing in different styles to look at characterisation and finish with a story with a flashback. We will move on to poetry linked to Remembrance Day to then looking at persuasive texts.



We will be looking at the human and physical geography of North and South America, moving on to a research study on the city of Mexico, which links to our learning we have done on the Maya.

# Art and DT

In art we will be looking at Christmas crafts and creating pieces for the church

We will be looking into the foods of North and South America, specifically Mexico in DT.

# Music

All learning is based on the theme 'Classroom Jazz 2'
The children will be learning to improve their singing and rhythmic skills during this time.



# Maths

Maths will see us start with fractions and carry on for a few weeks. This will then move on to measurements, looking at conversions, time area and capacity.

# P.E

This half term will see us continue with swimming and have lessons delivered by Mr Lofthouse from OLCC.

#### German

Year 6 have loved German so far. We will be learning the days and months of the year and continue to say numbers up to 100. This will help us say when our birthday is.

# Science

Science will see us look at living things and their habitats.
