

Spring 2: Learning in Year 3



English

This half term we will complete our non-chronological report about animals. We will create a newspaper account of the Roman invasion and then investigate the myth of how Rome was created. There will be lots of reading, writing and spellings.

Supporting your child with their learning

- * Ask your child about what they have been learning.
- * Practise counting in 4s, and 8s.
- * Talk about the book they are reading: 'What has just happened? who is the main character? Do you like them? Why?'

Science

In Science we will be finding out more about health and nutrition. We will review what the benefits are of healthy eating and its impact on our bodies. Our Scientist is Elsie Widdowson.

History and Geography

In History, we begin our Romans topic. We will start by looking at how and why the Romans invaded. We will also find out about the tribes that resisted the Romans too.

Maths

In Maths, we will be re-visiting money and shapes. We will also be going deeper into fractions and measures.

Computing

In ICT will be learning about simulations. The children will also have time to use the devices for research, reading and maths too.

Art and DT

This half term we will focus on textiles. We will revisit some joining skills and make our own resources from different textiles.

The children will work on their athletics and outdoor skills. PE will be Tuesday and Thursday.

PSHE

We will be continuing to work on identifying and managing our emotions. We will also reflect on why being healthy is important.

Music

We will continue to develop our skills in music through singing. The children will also have a chance to learn the basics of keyboards.

German

In German, we will learn the names of animals and try to describe them.
