### **English**

<u>Th</u>is term we shall be studying the text 'Friend or Foe' by Michael Morpurgo. We shall be writing newspaper reports and writing an extra scene based on the novel.

#### **History and Geography**

We will be learning about trade. We shall find out about exports and imports to and from the UK and which products are grown and sold in different countries around the world.

#### Art and DT

We will be finishing off our breadmaking project. We shall be designing and making our own bread.

#### Music

We shall be continuing to listen and appraise a range of different styles of music.

# Supporting your child with their learning

- Help your child learn the multiplication facts by heart. Different multiplication tables will be focused upon throughout the half term.
- Check that your child can tie their own shoelaces independently.
- Encourage your child to read for pleasure and talk about their current choice of book together.
- Practise 'telling the time' at home, first on a clock with hands then on a digital clock.

#### Maths

Maths will see us start with mental and written division, and sorting 2D and 3D shapes. Then, we will move onto calculating with fractions, area and volume, and finally statistics.

We will be continuing with swimming on a Tuesday and will have a Striking and Fielding lessons on a Wednesday.

#### German

This half term we will be learning how to say where we live, ask some simple questions, and begin to write in German!

### **Science**

In Science, we will be learning about the life cycles of a mammal, amphibian insect and bird. We will also find out about the reproduction of plants and some animals.

Our Scientist this half term is Jane Goodall. This half term also sees the return of our annual science week- more information will follow soon!
