## English

This term we are focusing on stories from other classical stories, beginning with Olivier's Vegetables! We will be creating instructions, narrative writing and informative leaflets using stories from other cultures. We will also be exploring poems that we will learn from heart!

## Science

## History and Geography

This half term will be focus on History. We will be exploring old toys, looking at what games children played with in the past and how they compare to the toys we use today.

## Maths

In maths this half term, we will be using multiplication and division, fractions and position and direction. We will continue to practise the 2s, 5s and 10s and number bonds!

## Computing

We are using coding this half term. We will use Purple Mash to help us code and use different applications to do so!

## Art and DT

We are focusing on design and technology this half term. We will be designing, making and evaluating our very own structures!

## P.E

This half term we move on from dance to gymnastics! We will be learning new skills and creating our very own routines!

## PSHE

In PSHE this half term we are exploring our mental health and feelings. We will look at different types of feelings and how to manage them. We will also focus on how to deal with loss and change.

## Music

We are using Charranga to explore the unit Your Imagination this half term. We will use different instruments to create a performance!

We come back from half term into Faith Week, which leads us into our Pentecost and reconciliation unit. We will be looking at what a Holy day is, the story of the Holy Spirit and then focusing on the choices we make and how Jesus forgives us.
