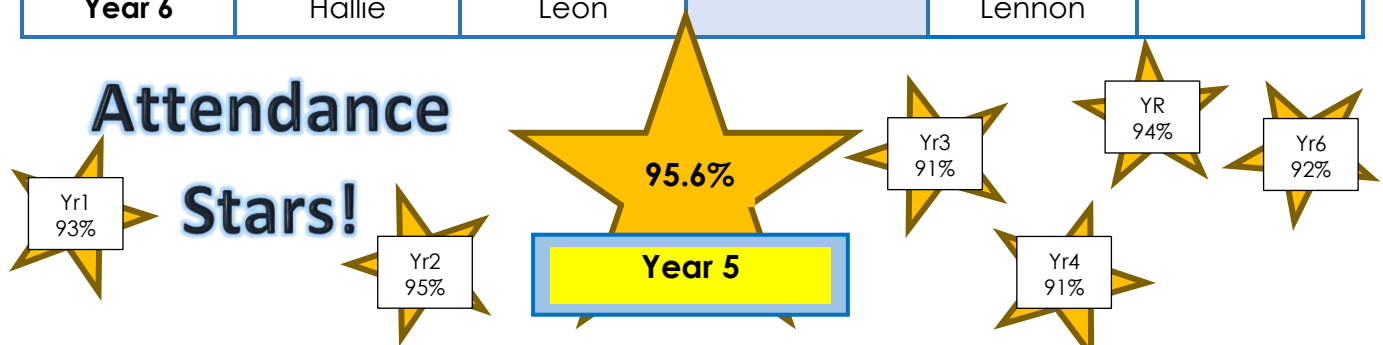

# School News

Nursery	In Nursery, like last week, they've been looking at transport. But, instead of looking at the present, they've been looking at the past – the history of transport! Talking about old-fashioned ways of transport, they've been on a journey on a steam train.

This week, in Science, this class have been looking at the properties of materials. Also like a while ago, they looked at Oliver's vegetables, but now, they've started writing about it!
Year Two	Year Two have learnt about their adored, beloved fabled hero Spiderman (and his supernatural abilities)! In English, they learnt something real called 'Questions'. For Art, they've been looking at the popular painter, Frida Kahlo! Like Year One, Year Two have been looking at fractions as well.
Year Three	Year Three have welcomed two new girls into our school family! Together they've been looking at poetry in English – collecting sounds for rhyming. Maths have seen Year Three using the traditional grid method!
Year Four	Year 4 has seen the end of the book Fox and will be starting a new novel shortly! With Science, they've been looking at States of Matter (Gas, Solids and Liquids). For Mathematics, Year 4 have been looking at decimals (fascinating stuff, am I right?)
Year Five	Year Five (like Year Three) have welcomed a new student to their class! She and the other Year Fives have been looking at Properties of Material. Related to the Properties of Materials, they've been researching thermal conductors. In Computing, they've made their own shapes, if that's even possible...
Year Six	Year Six have been training hard for their SATs, converting Mass and capacity. For English, they've made a persuasive letter to Miss. Griffiths to think about school uniform. Focusing on Religious Education, Year Six were learning about witnesses and witnessing, and what to do.
