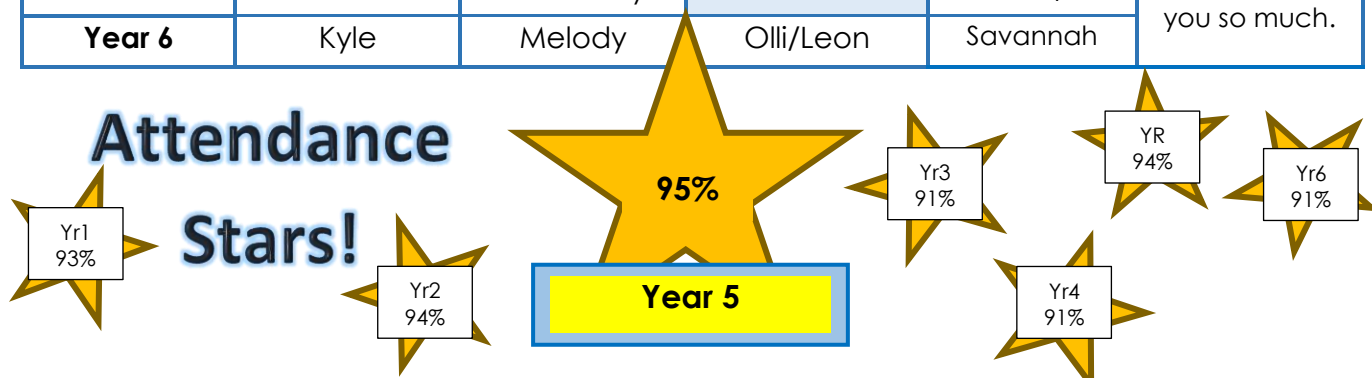
School News! **NEWS**
