

## Summer 2: Learning in Year 4



#### **English**

In English, we will read the novel 'The Firework Maker's Daughter', which will give us plenty of opportunities to perfect our writing. We will write a variety of texts including letters, diary entries and recounts.

#### Science

In Science, Year 4 will continue to learn about materials and their properties. We will group different materials and learn about their states of matter. We will also develop our scientific enquiry skills by setting up different tests.

#### <u>History</u>

In History, we will learn about Vikings and Anglo-Saxons. We will start with the invasion of the Vikings and how life in Britain changed because of them.

#### <u>Maths</u>

In Maths, we will work on our calculation this half term including addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also work on fractions and find fractions of shapes and amounts.

#### **Computing**

We will use our Computing skills to create collages. We will edit, format and change images for different purposes.

#### <u>DT</u>

In DT, we will plan, make and evaluate 3D models of Viking longboats. We will select our own materials depending on their properties and how good they are to build structures.

#### Music

In Music, we will continue to learn the song 'Blackbird' by the Beatles. We will sing and perform the song in front of an audience.

#### P.E

We will continue with Athletics this half term and incorporate adventurous, outdoor activities including orienteering.

### <u>PSHE</u>

In PSHE, our next unit is called 'Identity, society and equality'. Our work will include looking into what makes us individual and celebrate these. We will also look into ensuring everyone is treated equally.

#### **German**

In German, we will review our learning from this year with a project. This will include a presentation and an oral recount of our learning from this year.

#### <u>R.E</u>

Our RE of Pentecost will continue this half term. We will continue to describe the importance of the gifts from the Holy Spirit.

Our last RE unit will see us look at Reconciliation. This will include learning about the different sacraments, especially reconciliation. We will also think about how important it is to say sorry in order to be forgiven.
