English

We will be basing all our English work on the novel 'There's a boy in the girls' bathroom by Louis Sachar. We shall be writing play scripts, diaries and letters. We will also be learning about ways to create complex sentences and use a range of punctuation in our independent writing.

Geography

We shall be looking at the continent of Europe and then concentration on the region of the Costa Blanca
In Spain. We shall examine the physical and human features of this area and also the climate and relief.

Art
