English

We begin this year looking at adventure stories. From this we will be writing our own version, using description and clear punctuation. Then we will move to looking at poetry, considering what it would be like if we were in charge. We will continue our reading challenge and look forward to watching the children apply new skills.

Geography

In Geography, our topic is all about Settlements. We will look at where and how people use the space around them and different types of houses. We will find out why people settle in different areas.

Art

In art we will be linking our drawing and collage skills to create pictures of Settlements. We will be investigating creating colour and texture with different materials. As an extra challenge, we will make portraits in the style of Henri Matisse

Music

The children will be learning to play the recorder. They will be learning to improve their singing and rhythmic skills during this activity. We will introduce musical notation.
