

# Spring 2: Learning in Year 6



## English

In English, we will continue with lots of SATs preparations. We will be looking at different reading skills and our punctuation and grammar.

In writing, we will be looking at narrative poetry to inspire our stories and we will be writing a non-chronological report on animals.

## Supporting your child with their learning

- Practise timetables with inverse calculations too
- Get your child to read every night – this really does help
- Provide a quiet space to complete homework and help where you can
- Maths related – help your child tell the time.

## Science

Science will see us look at evolution and inheritance!

We will be able to recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.

In addition, we will learn to recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents.

## History and Geography

We will begin by finishing off our learning on the Maya.

Year 6 will then be working on a new Geography unit on Volcanoes and Earthquakes.

We will learn what happens during an earthquake, where in the world earthquakes are prone and why; alongside what is a volcano.

## Maths

We will be looking at area and perimeter and lots of SATs preparations.  
Extra work will be done to practise!

## Computing

Spring term sees us using revision sites for our SATs. ! Mrs Whittaker will help us navigate through this!

## P.E

We will be looking at orienteering this half term using the signs around school.

## PSHE

In PSHE we will be learning about Human Rights, including - people who have moved to Lancaster from other places, (including the experience of refugees); about human rights and the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child and about homelessness.

## Music

Our music will see us learn through the topic of 'You've got a friend.'  
We will be singing and performing in our lessons.

## German

This half term we will be exploring homes and houses.
