

Summer 1: Learning in Year 2



English

We begin this term by looking at animal adventure stories - The Owl who was afraid of the dark.

We will then be looking at poetry, focussing on Michael Rosen poems and performing them! Our final unit will be non-chronological reports about Owls!

Maths

We will be looking at partitioning numbers in different ways with a multiple of 10, ordering numbers through estimation, sequencing in 2's and 5's and 10's.

We will then look at temperature and measurements for capacity and volume! Towards the end of the half term we will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes and how to identify them with or without a line of symmetry.

We will recap time and compare different units of time and develop a deeper understanding of the language related to time.

Science

This half term, we will look at food chains! We will be looking at how one animal effects another. We will be looking at the 'domino effect' of one animal being different.

We will look at the similarities and differences between food chains and linking them to their habitats.

Supporting your child with their learning

Reading - We encourage our children to read at home at least 3 times a week. Make sure to sign your child's reading diary when you listen to them read!

Geography

This half term we will be looking at the different weathers in the UK. We will be monitoring the weather throughout the half term and comparing that data to weather in different regions.

We will then look at why the weather is different in different areas!

R.E

Our RE this half term is all about The Ends of the Earth. We will be looking at the Ascensionism, the Pentecost, the conversion of Saul and then looking at St Francis of Assisi.

P.E

We are looking at Gymnastics. We will be using our skills from our dance unit last half term to explore movement in more depth.

ART

This half term we will be looking at the artist Frida Kahlo. We will be looking at the techniques she used and creating a portrait in the same style!

Computing

This half term we will be looking at spreadsheets and making music with them!
We will be looking at how to use spreadsheets and what they are used for!

PSHE

Our PSHE unit this half term is all about keeping safe and managing risks appropriately! We will also be looking at the different ways people communicate with each other. We will be looking at this in the set lessons as well as across different areas of the curriculum!
