We use **FANTASTIC WALKING** to keep everyone safe in school and to ensure that the learning of others is not disrupted as we move around school.



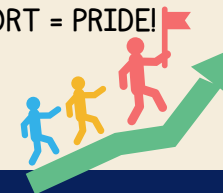
FANTASTIC LISTENING

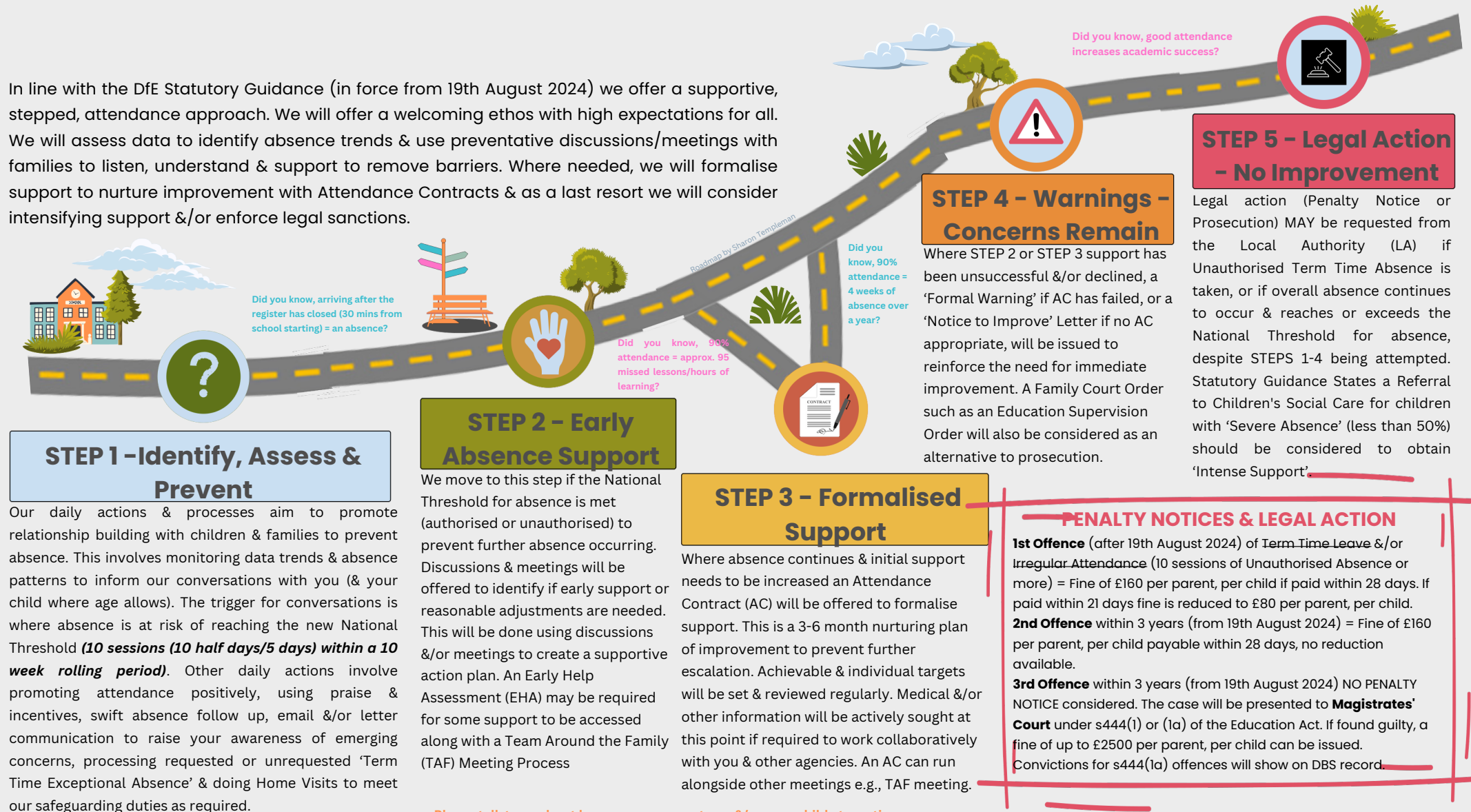
