

# Summer 2: Learning in Year 2



### **English**

We begin this term by looking at stories with themes, focussing on 'The Gigantic Turnip'! We will then look at how to write clues to find something, as well as describing plants! We will end the year by writing letters to our new class teacher exploring what we are looking forward to and what we may be nervous about.

### <u>Maths</u>

We will be looking at measuring mass and capacity in different ways. We will use weighing scales to look at how the different mass effects scales. We will then move onto position and direction. Using our language skills to describe the position and direction of an object compared to another. We will end the term by looking at fractions and statistics - recapping what we have already covered to make sure we have a great start to our new academic year!

#### Science

This half term, we will look at materials and their uses. We will begin with a carousel activity, looking at the different materials around us and what they are used for and why!

We will explore texture and whether they are appropriate for different uses.

<u>Supporting your child with their learning</u> Learning logs – each week we send home homework tasks – these are accessible on Class Dojo.

**Reading** – We encourage our children to read at home at least 3 times a week. Make sure to sign your child's reading diary when you listen to them read!

### <u>History</u>

This half term we will be looking at the impact of Lord Ashton on Lancaster. We will be looking at the different impacts of the buildings curated by Lord Ashton or erected in honor of him.

# <u>R.E</u>

Our RE this half term is all about Dialogue and Encounters. We will be looking at what happens during Mass (and why), the Good Samaritan, the Christian community, Judaism and The Shabbat.

### <u>P.E</u>

We are focussing on refining our Fine Motor skills and movement. We will be looking at how we run, jump, hop, throw and catch effectively.

### <u>DT</u>

This half term we will be looking at structures. We will be looking at how to make structures sturdy through a plan, design and review process!

### Computing

This half term we will be looking at questioning! We will look at how answers to questions may alter the questions that follow!

## <u>PSHE</u>

Our PSHE unit this half term is all about Medicines and how to use them safely. We will also cover drug, alcohol and tobacco. We will end the year by looking at knowing where we belong.

### <u>Music</u>

We will continue to follow the Charanga music scheme and be looking at Rhyme and Rhythm!
