Lighting the Path

- Recognition in an age-appropriate way that the Church teaches that all that is comes from God, Our Father, who made heaven and earth
- Be introduced to the story of Creation in Genesis 1, as a prayerful and poetic reflection on God's world and be able to retell this story in any form

- Recognise that, for Christians, the Christmas story reveals God's love by sending Jesus, his Son
- Be introduced to the Bible as a special book and encounter stories and accounts of how people came to know God and the Good News of Jesus in the gospels
- Sequence St. Luke's account of the infancy of Jesus and recognise the significance of an angelic presence
- Recognise that, for Christians, the Christmas story reveals God's love by sending Jesus his Son
- Know that in the Annunciation God called Mary and she said yes to his call and why this makes Mary important for Christians
