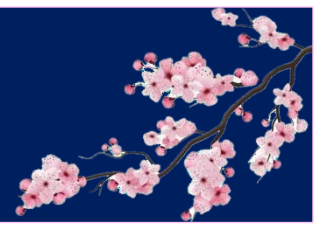

SATs Week

Year 4 – Upcoming Multiplication Tables Check

Year 4 pupils will soon be taking part in the statutory Multiplication Tables Check (MTC). This national assessment is designed to assess pupils' rapid recall of multiplication facts up to 12×12 and plays an important role in supporting their wider mathematical learning.

We strongly encourage regular practice at home in the lead up to the check, as this will support pupils in becoming more secure and confident with their recall. Short, frequent practice sessions can make a significant difference.

We would like to thank parents and carers for your continued support in helping pupils prepare for this.

Reading at Home

We kindly remind parents and carers of the importance of regular reading at home. All children from Reception to Y6 should aim to read at least three times per week, as this plays a vital role in developing fluency, confidence and a love of reading.

Please ensure that your child brings their reading book and reading record into school each day and that this is signed regularly. Thank you for your continued support in helping your child make the best possible progress.

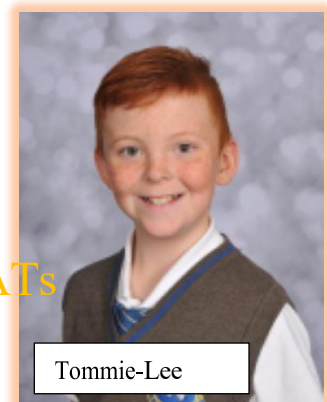

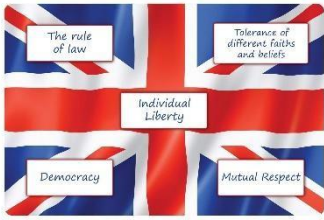
